- Council of the School of Physical Sciences
- Council of the School of Technology

Each of the above roles is open to students registered for courses within that School. Councils are generally concerned with the wider strategic goals of the Departments within their areas, so these representatives should anticipate providing wide-ranging feedback on matters of resourcing, estates, new courses, and regulations.

Note that the School of Clinical Medicine does not elect separate representatives; the Faculty Board representatives (in the table below, those listed for "medicine") serve in this role.
